Hertfordshire County Council (Graveley 15, 18 and 21 and Wymondley 24) Modification Order 2016

The above Order was made on 19th February 2016 and was advertised for the statutory period of 42 days.

No objections to the Order were received in respect of Green Lane (Graveley 21) and Turf Lane (Graveley 15/ Wymondley 24). As a result Hertfordshire County Council severed the Order and confirmed that part of it, in respect of Green Lane and Turf Lane, on 16th November 2017.

In respect of Milksey Lane (Graveley 18) this part of the Order was confirmed with modifications, on 13th November 2020, by an inspector following a public inquiry and written representations.

We are now serving you with notice of the confirmation of the Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement by adding to them:

- a bridleway on Green Lane (Graveley 21)
- a greater width of footpath on Milksey Lane (Graveley 18)
- a restricted byway on Turf Lane (Graveley 15/ Wymondley 24), and

 deleting from them that part of Graveley Footpath 15 between points D and E on the Order Plan as it is already all-purpose public highway.

It is possible for anyone to question the validity of an order by making an application to the High Court within 42 days from the date of the publication of this confirmation. The grounds on which an appeal can be made are specified in paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

For a challenge to be successful, the person making the appeal would have to show that:

- The legislation was not applied correctly when confirming this Order; or
- The County Council has not followed the required legal procedures

(ii) that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description; or

(iii) that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. Hertfordshire County Council hereby order that:


- 1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 6th December 2015.

- This Order is made under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. It is known as the Hertfordshire County Council (Graveley 15, 18 and 21 and Wymondley 24) Modification Order 2016.
- The Order is dated 19 February 2016. It proposes to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a bridleway, upgrading a footpath to restricted byway status and upgrading a footpath to a bridleway along Green Lane, Turf Lane and Milksey Lane respectively, in the parishes of Graveley and Wymondley, as described in the Order. Only the status of Milksey Lane is at issue here.
- There was one objection outstanding when Hertfordshire County Council submitted the Order for confirmation to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs.
- In accordance with Paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 I gave notice of my proposal to confirm the Order with modifications, to which three objections were submitted. I subsequently gave notice of my proposal to confirm the Order with further modifications; no objections have been received in response.

Summary of Decision: The Order is confirmed subject to modifications previously proposed.

Reasons

- 1. If confirmed with the modifications set out in paragraph 53 of my interim Order Decision issued on 1 July 2020, the Order would not record on the definitive map and statement a bridleway as originally proposed. Further, the route at issue here, Footpath No 18 (Graveley), would not be recorded over the full width of the lane as shown in the Order as made but would exclude (a) a narrow strip along its southern side (in effect the raised roadside verge), (b) a small triangle of land near to its junction with Restricted Byway 15 in Graveley Parish (shown on the Order map as point B) and (c) an area on the south side of Milksey Lane immediately to the west of the gate at point C. Nevertheless, the Order would confirm the existence of a public right of way on foot over the remaining width of Milksey Lane shaded grey on the Order map. No limitations would be recorded on the definitive statement for Footpath 18 (Graveley).
- 2. There are no objections to these proposed modifications to the Order.

Conclusion

3. Having regard to the above and to all other matters raised at the inquiry and in the written representations, I conclude the Order should be confirmed subject to the modifications that have been advertised and as set out below.

Formal Decision

4. I confirm the Order subject to the following modifications:

In the Order schedule

- In Part I: Modification of the Definitive Map `Description of public right of way to be upgraded': delete the entry for Milksey Lane;
- In Part II: Modification of the Definitive Statement 'Variation of particulars of path or way': amend 'Width' to read "Between 1.83m and 8m...";
- Change all references to 'Bridleway' (or 'BR') 18 to 'Footpath' (or 'FP') 18;

On the Order map

- Delete from the key "footpath to be upgraded to bridleway (B-C)" and amend "Existing footpath" to read "Existing footpath/footpath to be recorded with additional width (B-C);
- Amend the notation used on the map for B-C to that for the above and reduce the area shaded grey.
