


Please come and help shape your Graveley village



BECOME A PARISH COUNCILLOR

Are you interested in the life of your village, your parish, your local environment, recreational facilities, planning and housing issues? Just a few of the areas where the Graveley Parish Council gets involved to help make a difference to the Graveley community.

Graveley Parish Council is seeking to co-opt a volunteer parish councillor. The Council meets approximately 10 times a year, usually on the third Tuesday of the month for about an hour, normally at the Village Hall following Government guidelines for any Covid19 measures, when necessary.

Pre-requisites to become a Parish Councillor

Applicants must be at least 18 years old on the date of co-option and be on the current electoral register.

That you have lived in the parish or within 3 miles/4.8kms of the parish boundary (as the crow flies) for at least 12 months. Either your main place of business is based in the parish or you own/rent a property within the parish.

If successful, you will be required to complete an entry in the Parish Council's Register of Members' interests. This involves putting your address, employment, relevant major shareholdings and membership of charities, pressure groups, political parties etc on public record. You will also be required to sign up to the GPC Code of conduct.
