24/067	<p>Clerks report</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bonfires at 1a High Street - The Environmental Crime Officer, Enforcement Team East Anglia will visit the site some time. They had been in touch with a resident adjacent to the site and asked for them to inform them if they carried out any more bonfires to let them know. • No other updates from North Herts Council regarding 1a High Street and the enforcement notice, etc. • Two of the benches have been mended and painted. One on Church lane and the other up by Ashwell Close. • The Clerk will look to have the bench outside Graveley School painted in October and for the GPC to vote on this at the October meeting and suggested getting a quote to paint the bollards on the grass verge area at the back of the Waggon and Horses pub. • NHC asked for suggested road names from Graveley Parish Council for the new development, 4 dwellings rear of Gothic House, Graveley. The developer had suggested Gothic Grove, but two of the GPC councillors found the name ‘too jarring – too many g’s’ and ‘doesn’t sound great’. Other road names were suggested and it was agreed that the road be called Gothic Bower. • The traverse net has been replaced in the Playground. • The Clerk had received a request to consider a donation towards the open afternoon event held in August or towards the ongoing upkeep of St Mary’s Church – have acknowledged and asked for accounts as per the normal policy. To be added as an agenda item, once received. • Footpath 17 – Not heard back from HCC about the maintenance of

Clerk to follow up with Cllr Steve Jarvis.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hedges around Pondsides and the allotment/Playground/culvert within the field to be cut back by the farmer. • Affinity Water will be installing a new water main along High Street, Graveley, SG4 7LA, from the junction of Milksey Lane to the junction of Graveley Lane. Due to start on Tuesday 17th September – 21st December 2024. Graveley Lane will be closed from 30th September until 21st December but access for residents will be maintained throughout and there will be a suitable diversion route in place. The High Street will have two way temporary traffic signals from 17th September until 28th October 2024.
