	a) To discuss a schedule for grass cutting in the Playground. The grass cutting maintenance of the Playground was discussed and that it had some tidying up but the main cut was not carried out until after the summer holidays. The Clerk had made the GPC aware that the gardener had been unwell over the summer months. It was agreed for the Clerk to put some wording so that a schedule for grass cutting maintenance could be prepared for the councillors to review at the next meeting.
	b) To discuss the cleaning of the village benches. The bench up on Ashwell Close was reported as being dirty with bird droppings last month. The bench is under a tree, but it was discussed that the bench is in a good location for when villagers walk up from Pondside to get some rest and some shelter/shade. Cllr Lumley has cleaned the bench. Cllr Lumley volunteered to clean the bench on Ashwell Close once a month, as necessary. Cllr Griffin volunteered to clean it next time. Cllr Lumley to keep an eye on the bench for when it needed a clean.
25/059	 Clerks report The Village Hall have a booking for Tuesdays for 2026 and so they would like the GPC to move their meeting date to a Wednesday at 8pm. The Clerk will be adding this onto next month's agenda for voting on. Most of the village benches have been painted and maintained. The railings around the pond have been painted. September precept received from North Herts District Council - £5328.00. The Clerk has sent a note to Steve Jarvis to ask if the bollards could be painted in the High Street. Playground hedge cutting has been booked in for the end of September/beginning of October. The Clerk will contact the farmer to cut the tops once this work has been carried out. Bollard up by Ashwell Close was reported and has been fixed. To report that it needs some sort of reflector strip added to it. In August, the Clerk and Cllr Lumley received an email from the Planning Enforcement office reported in March 2025 regarding the felling of some trees adjacent to the site north of 1A High Street. They have completed their investigations and they have closed the case due to no breach being established. They stated that the tree removal in this section is in line with the work expected for this site on the planning history. The Clerk will be updating the policies and drafting the budget for 2026/2027 for next month's meeting.
