- The postholders above are carried over into 2021/22 in their current roles.
- The balance of the account was £1286.99 in January 2020. Expenditure last year was on plants and compost for the central reservations totalling £154.25. This leaves a balance as of January 2021 of £1132.74.
- Activity during the year was largely confined to weeding, planting and watering the central reservations. There was no invitation to residents to participate due to restrictions in place. Thanks are extended to a small number of villagers who helped with the tasks and especially Marion Bracey for her help with bringing water during the long dry spell of weather.
- Some homegrown baskets of Purple Loosestrife were placed in both ponds and marginal reed clearing done by members of the group.
- The usual planting and composting of the central reservations is planned for the coming year together with small scale pond maintenance as necessary. No further projects are feasible currently.
