GRAVELEY PARISH COUNCIL – GRANTS

GUIDELINES FOR COUNCILLORS

- All applications to be supported with the group's latest set of accounts/balance sheet.
- A full description of what the grant is to be used for is required in writing.
- The parish Council should be aware of what grants are available from the District Council and put the applicants in touch with the appropriate person, where possible.
- Grants for new groups are available for any initial costs.
- Grants should not be made to help with the day to day running costs the exceptions to this, would be disadvantaged groups, youth organisations and the ground maintenance of the church.
- Community days should be supported. (e.g. the Great Ashby Fun Day).
- For grants of £1500.00 or more, GPC should request the applicant to supply 2 quotations and 1 quotation to be supplied for requests of under £1500.00.
- When a Parish Councillor declares an interest, they should leave the room, whilst the debate takes place.
