

# **GRAVELEY PARISH COUNCIL – GRANTS**

## **GUIDELINES FOR COUNCILLORS**

- All applications to be supported with the group's latest set of accounts/balance sheet.
- A full description of what the grant is to be used for is required in writing.
- The parish Council should be aware of what grants are available from the District Council and put the applicants in touch with the appropriate person, where possible.
- Grants for new groups are available for any initial costs.
  
- Grants should not be made to help with the day to day running costs – the exceptions to this, would be disadvantaged groups, youth organisations and the ground maintenance of the church.
- Community days should be supported. (e.g. the Great Ashby Fun Day).
- For grants of £1500.00 or more, GPC should request the applicant to supply 2 quotations and 1 quotation to be supplied for requests of under £1500.00.
- When a Parish Councillor declares an interest, they should leave the room, whilst the debate takes place.
